Circular

“Make in Maharashtra” on the lines of “Make in India” the campaign for the implementation of the government policy to boost its industry sector, to control quality of factory and shall implement a specific operating system besides managing the interests of the workers who works in the factory is the policy of the government. Accordingly for the effective implementation of the Factories Act, 1948, the government has approved the Randomization inspection scheme for the Random inspection with reference said government circular.

With reference to government circular dated 22/06/2015, at point no-2, following partial changes has been made in the procedures of state level inspection committee:-

Procedure No-1

State level inspection committee will select the 20% of the factories (others factories) once in a year for inspection excluding the Major accidents hazards which comes under rule 2 (D) of The Maharashtra Factories (Control of Industrial Major Accident Hazards) Rules, 2003, hazardous process factories and chemical factories under section 2 (cb) of The Factories Act, 1948 and registered saw mills and power looms comes under section 85 of The factories Act, 1948.

Visit/inspection of factory inspector shall not be a part of randomization inspection scheme if accident took place in any type of factories or complaint received about the factories.

As per randomization inspection scheme, state level inspection committee will select all Major accidents hazards factories, hazardous process and chemical factory for inspection once in a year. It means inspection all Major accidents hazards factory; hazardous process and chemical factory will be done every year.

State level committee and all other procedure shall be as per procedure referred in government resolution dated 22/06/2015 for doing inspection of factories as per randomization process.
